

# Google Maps Route Planner

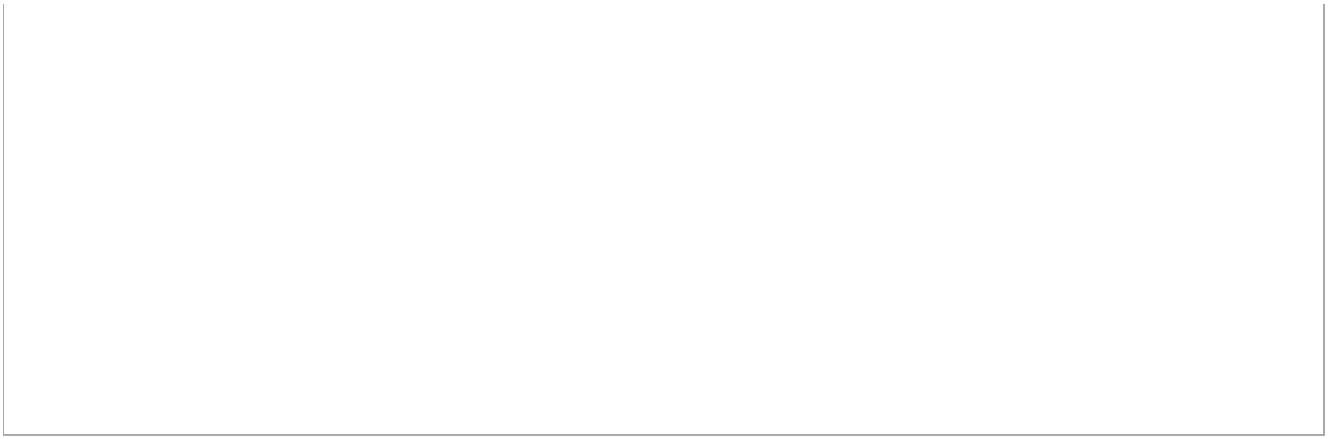
